

Specific Rules of Conduct

The following rules will be in effect while attending any event in which the Cobra Hockey Club attends.

- A. Players will not possess, use or dispense any alcoholic beverage.
- B. Players will not possess or use any illegal drug, controlled substance and/or paraphernalia.
- C. Players will not be involved in the theft or willful destruction of any property.
- D. Players will not have in their possession, or dispense any tobacco product, unless of legal age set by state or federal law.
 - 1. Any player in violation of rules A, B, or C will receive a mandatory four (4) game suspension and may be expelled from the team. If the player is a **(Coaches Decision)** captain or assistant captain he will be stripped of that rank.
 - 2. Any player in violation of rule D will receive a two (2) game suspension.
 - 3. In order to maintain the effective discipline of the team, any player may be suspended no more than one game in succession by the coach. This action is non-reviewable by the Board of Directors. However, any such action shall be reported to the Board in writing, setting forth the reason for the suspension.
 - 4. In matters, which require appearance before the Board, the Board shall hold a hearing as soon as practicable either upon receipt of the request for such action, or upon the request of any member of the organization. The request must be signed in writing and set forth the reasons for such hearing. In any event, the hearing shall be held within ninety-six (96) hours of the request unless waived by the player.
 - 5. The player may be represented at the hearing in his own proper person, or by anyone so designated by the player. A parent must be present. The player may call witnesses, only upon permission granted by the Board for the orderly conduct of the hearing.

The Board shall review the facts of the case and render a decision within twenty-four (24) hours of the hearing, in writing. The final decisions shall be in writing and made a part of the player's permanent record. The decision of the Board is reviewable only upon a motion by at least three (3) members.
