

Magnetic Jewelry Clasp

Never struggle with a necklace or bracelet again! The magnetic clasp replaces spring clips and other tricky fasteners with a simple magnetic closure. Connections are instant and removal requires only a gentle tug. Also a terrific way to rescue broken clasps.

Instructions:

1. Open Lobster Catch by pressing down on lever. Place closed ring or clip from your bracelet or necklace inside Lobster Catch and release lever to close and make connection.
2. Open catch from your bracelet or necklace. Place closed ring from magnetic clasp inside open catch and release to make connection.
3. Gently pull both ends of the magnetic clasp to open.

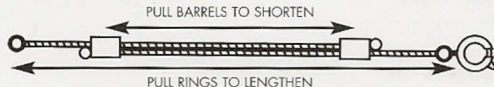
Adjustable 3-6 inch Necklace Extender

Quantity 2 (one of each color)

Make any necklace 3 to 6 inches longer.

Instructions:

1. Connect Extender ring to existing loop on necklace.
2. Connect clasp on Extender to ring on necklace.
3. Adjust length of Extender.

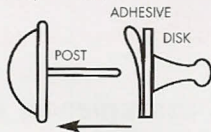


Repair-a-Tear

Quantity 4 sheets

Instructions:

1. Remove adhesive cover from one circle on the sheet. Do not touch the adhesive.
2. Choose disk or stabilizer, depending on earring and application.
3. Position disk / stabilizer on top of exposed adhesive and press down. As you lift, adhesive will be attached.
4. Using earring post, pierce adhesive at center hole of disk.
5. Insert post into highest point in pierced ear opening. Apply disk to post on back of ear with adhesive side adhering to back of ear lobe.
6. To replace, remove earring, take adhesive disk off back of ear lobe and peel adhesive from disk. Apply new Repair-a-Tear.



Hooker™ 3 in 1 Fastener

Bracelet Fastener Attach clip to eyelet or open end of bracelet. Place Hooker™ in hand with palm facing up and clip pointing toward elbow. Bracelet should dangle from thumb side of hand. Hold clasp end of bracelet with free hand, and attach to eyelet or open end of bracelet. Release clip after clasp is secured.

Zipper Assist For better grip, remove rubber tips from clip and attach to zipper tab. Holding gripper at opposite end of grip, reach behind and pull to extend Hooker™, pulling up on zipper tab to close. Pull down on zipper tab to open. When finished, detach clip from zipper tab and replace rubber tips on clip.

Button Pull Place clip end of Hooker™ in hand and open button pull swivel to full extension. Push Button Pull through buttonhole and place wire hook securely over button. Secure buttonhole edge of shirt with free hand and pull wire hook through buttonhole. Remove wire hook after button has been completely pulled through buttonhole.

The Comfees Hooker™ can also be used for claspung necklaces and securing cufflinks.
